### **3. Minutes from the January 23<sup>rd</sup> ECDC General Membership Meeting**

El Cerrito Democratic Club

#### **Call to Order**

President Brown called the meeting to order at 6.35 p.m.

#### **Approval of January 2024 Agenda (Action Item)**

#### **Officer Reports: Membership, Publications, Media, and Records**

- **Membership** 83 members. A little low, but expect more memberships as endorsement forums are held.
- **Media** There were some unauthorized and heated posts on Facebook that were removed and the offending person was banned.

#### **Democratic Party of Contra Costa County (DPCCC) Report**

- **Nye District 1** Election season is coming and the clubs will be doing endorsements. Figuring out with other clubs how to work together. Deciding dates for endorsements. Trying to work together to avoid tiring candidates out.

## Year Budget - Ed Crowley, Treasurer (Action Item)

### Bullet Points on 2023

- Ended the year with a \$9500 balance
- Spent \$664 of reserves against a budget of \$8600.
- Did not spend on room rental because it was prepaid in 2022. For 2024, the room rental will book into the current year.
- Annual Dinner lost about \$1,000 but had fewer attendees, and maybe ticket prices could have gone up.
- Political contributions were not spent.
- Operating expenses only spent for office supplies and membership
- Communications and PO box underspent
- Budgeted \$13,000 and spent \$5100.
- Income: \$4800 in revenue. Dues were OK, but the dinner revenue was about \$1,000 under for above reasons.
